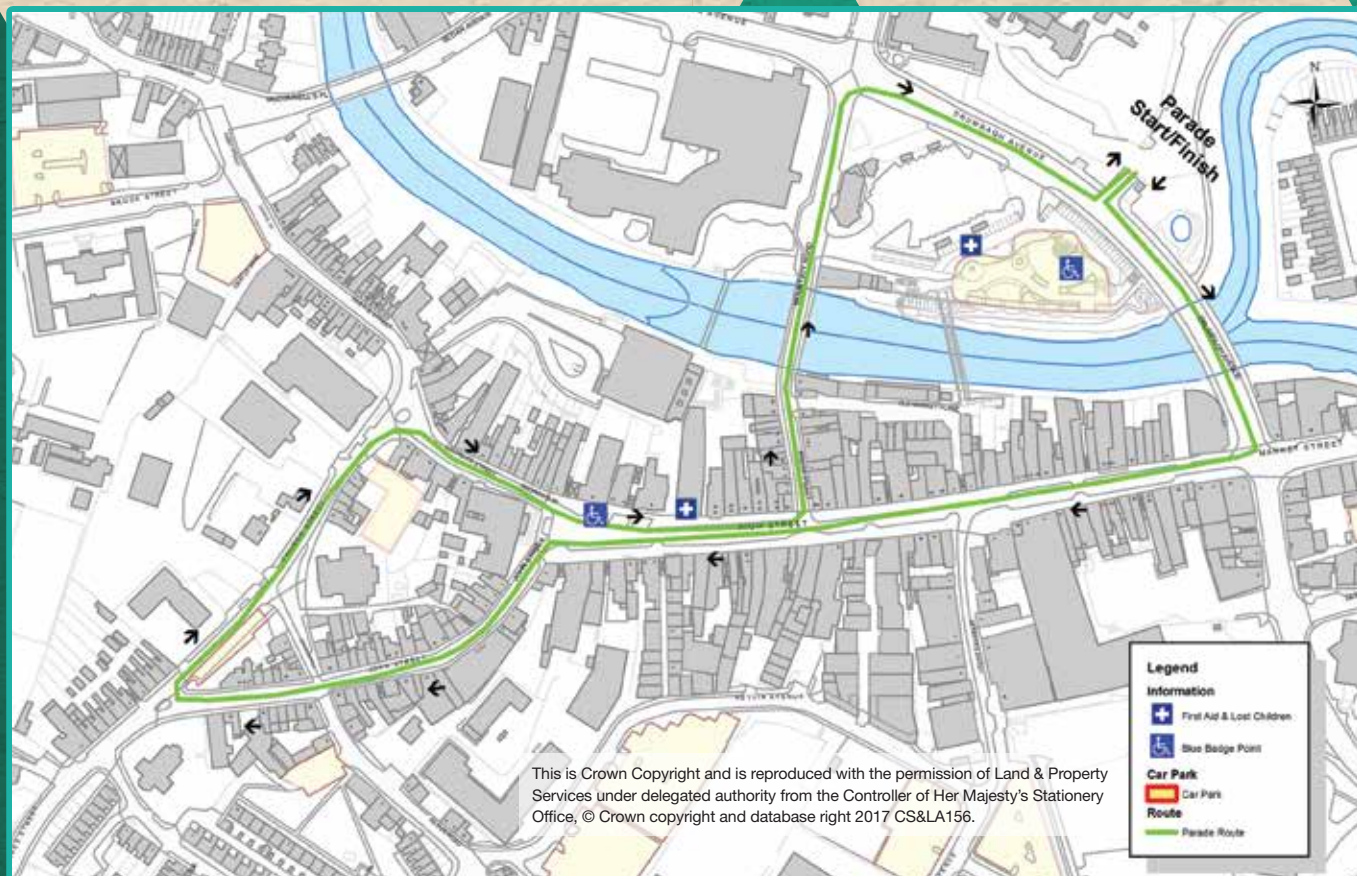
## Omagh Community House
