

SPORTS AWARDS 2017

Introduction

Fermanagh & Omagh Sports Forum organises the Annual Sports Awards presentation event on behalf of Fermanagh & Omagh District Council.

The Sports Awards recognise those teams and individuals who have made a particular contribution to sport in the District.

Anyone can submit a nomination. It is not necessary to submit a number of nominations for one candidate as the final nominee selection will be made by Fermanagh & Omagh Sports Forum and will not be based on the number of nominations received.

The award recipients will be announced at the Sports Awards presentation evening in the Silverbirch Hotel, Omagh on Friday 23 February 2018.

Categories and criteria to nominate athletes and teams are as follows:



Senior Sports Personality (18yrs old or over)

- Athletes must have competed or must be competing at senior level.
- Athletes must reside within the Fermanagh & Omagh District area.
- Their sport is recognised by Sport NI or Sport Ireland.



Junior Sports Personality (14 - 18yrs old)

- Athletes must reside within the Fermanagh & Omagh District area.
- Their sport is recognised by Sport NI or Sport Ireland.



Juvenile Sports Personality (14yrs old & younger)

- Athletes must reside within the Fermanagh & Omagh District area.
- Their sport is recognised by Sport NI or Sport Ireland.



Senior Sports Team

- The team is competing at senior level.
- The team is from within the Fermanagh & Omagh District area.
- Their sport is recognised by Sport NI or Sport Ireland.



Junior Sports Team

- The team is competing at junior level.
- The team is from within the Fermanagh & Omagh District area.
- The sport is recognised by Sport NI or Sport Ireland.

Coach of the Year

This Award recognises coaches who have had success at the highest levels working with talented athletes or teams

- The coach must be working with a team or with athletes based in the Fermanagh & Omagh District area.
- The sport they are involved in is recognised by Sport NI or Sport Ireland.
- The coach has achieved sporting success.



Disability Sports Coach of the Year

This Award recognises the achievements of a coach working to develop disabled athletes.

- The coach must reside within the Fermanagh & Omagh District area.
- The teams or athletes they are working with must be based within the Fermanagh & Omagh area.
- The sport they are involved in must be recognised by Sport NI or Ireland or Disability Sport NI.
- The coach must be a volunteer.
- The coach must have demonstrated unconditional commitment to their sport.



Service to Sport Award

This Award recognises the work, dedication and contribution of an individual over a number of years to help support, develop local clubs, leagues, teams or athletes.

- Must reside within the Fermanagh & Omagh District area.
- Must have been involved over a number of years in supporting and developing sport within the Fermanagh & Omagh District area.
- The sport they are involved in must be recognised by Sport NI, Sport Ireland or Disability Sport NI.
- Is/was a volunteer.
- Has demonstrated unconditional commitment to their sport.
- Been involved for approximately 20 years.
- Be an unsung hero.



Outstanding Achievement Award

This Award recognises athletes, teams, coaches, volunteers or administrators who have contributed to the sporting success of the District over the past year. For an outstanding achievement award potential nominees must meet any of the following criteria.

- Have contributed to success or helped others achieve.
- An athlete or team who has or had success that is not top level but should be recognised.
- Performed in the face of adversity.
- Inspires others.
- Recipients must reside in Fermanagh & Omagh District Council area.
- The sport they are involved in is recognised by Sport NI, Sport Ireland or Disability NI.
