### **Fermanagh and Omagh District Council Launches €5.6 Million PEACEPLUS Local Action Plan, Enniskillen, Northern Ireland – 2 October 2025**

Fermanagh and Omagh District Council have officially launched its PEACEPLUS Local Action Plan at a networking event held in the Killyhevlin Hotel, Enniskillen. The Council has been awarded over €5.6 million in funding to deliver 13 programmes under the PEACEPLUS initiative, aimed at addressing key social, economic, and environmental priorities across the district.

The Local Action Plan was developed through extensive consultation with local communities and reflects a shared vision for a more inclusive, resilient, and connected region. The programmes will be delivered over the next 24 to 36 months and are designed to bring tangible benefits to people of all ages and backgrounds.

The event provided an opportunity for delivery partners to present their programme activities and outline how they will contribute to the overall goals of the PEACEPLUS initiative. Attendees heard how the projects align with the Fermanagh and Omagh 2030 Community Plan, which focuses on building a healthy and inclusive community, with particular emphasis on supporting young people, older people, and families.

Cross-border collaboration and cultural heritage initiatives were also highlighted as key components of the plan, promoting mutual understanding and reconciliation across communities.

The Council acknowledged the vital contributions of its elected members, PEACEPLUS Partnership representatives, and the Community Services team in supporting the development and promotion of the Local Action Plan. Their ongoing efforts ensure that residents from all community backgrounds are informed, engaged, and represented.
