

## **MOREwoods (Woodland Trust scheme supported by Lloyds Bank)**

This scheme covers 0.5ha+ of trees planted and is open to all landowners.

- Self-plant - Woodland Trust will cover 75% of the cost of supply and delivery of trees, guards and canes.
- Contractor plant – Woodland Trust will cover 60% total cost of supply and delivery of trees, guards and canes plus arrange for a contractor to plant the trees, undertake a follow up inspection and weed control (if required) two years after planting.

Planting may be in multiple blocks. Ground preparation or fencing costs not included. Cannot claim Basic Payment Scheme on area planted.

## **MOREhedges (Woodland Trust scheme supported by Lloyds Bank)**

This is a self-plant scheme for new native hedgerows. Woodland Trust will cover 75% total cost of supply and delivery of hedging, guards and canes.

Funding is for 100-250m of hedge but can fund up to 1000m if done in conjunction with additional woodland creation through the MOREwoods scheme.

Open to all landowners but does not include support for ground preparation, fencing costs or replanting existing hedgerows.

## DAERA Small Woodland Grant Scheme (0.2ha +)

- Offers establishment funding to cover ground preparation, tree supply, guards, fencing costs, planting labour etc. (80% claimed in Year 1, 20% claimed in Year 5)
- Annual payment of up to £350 per ha for 10 years after planting
- Retention of Basic Payment Scheme on area planted
- Can be in multiple blocks across the farm (minimum block size 0.20ha, minimum block width 10m)
- Allows for up to 20% open space per block

## DAERA Forest Expansion Scheme (3 Ha+)

- Offers establishment funding to cover ground preparation, tree supply, guards, fencing costs, planting labour, etc.
- Annual payment for 10 years after planting (rates dependent on land category type)
- Retention of Basic Payment Scheme on area planted
- One single block of at least 3 hectares or more
- Allows for up to 20% open space



## DAERA Environmental Farming Scheme (EFS)

A 5 year agri-environment scheme offering funding for a range of options including:

- New native hedgerow planting
- Riparian buffer strips (planted with native trees)
- Establishment of agroforestry
- Tree corridors
- Native woodland creation up to 5ha
- Natural regeneration of existing native woodland
- Creation of traditional orchards
