## Re-using items

- Reduces the amount of waste sent to landfill and associated environmental costs. It is estimated that re-use in the UK diverts over 11,000 tonnes of waste from landfill saving over 380,000 tonnes of CO2
- Reduces disposal costs saving money to the local rate payers
- Has social benefits, helping your local community especially those in need
