Fermanagh and Omagh District Council Area

Location : Murley Wind Farm, Townlands of Glengesh Lower Forest and Moysnaght.

Proposal : An amendment to the overall tip height of the consented Murley Wind Farm (2 Turbines) from 126.5m to 149.9m (consented under K/2015/0066/F). Turbine geometry to be considered includes blade lengths of between 50m and 63m and hub heights of between 86.9m and 99.9m. The proposal also includes an application to vary planning condition 25 years to 35 years from the date of which the wind farm is connected to the electricity grid.
