**Location** : Lands approx. 1800m NE of 26 Cornavarrow Road, Dooish, Drumquin

**Proposal** : Proposed amendment to consented Pigeon Top Wind Farm (K/2009/0081/F and K/2011/0592/F) comprising 9 no. wind turbines and associated infrastructure, to change turbine dimensions and also turbine tip height up to 142.5m. The proposal includes slight amendment of previously approved access track routes, hardstand design and a new 80m met mast. The proposal also includes change in the wind farm operational period from 25 years to 35 years, from the date of which the wind farm is connected to the electricity grid.
