Your guide to what can be recycled in your blue recycling bin.  
Remember to ensure your items are:

## Clean, Dry, Empty & Flat

### ✓ Paper

- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Letters and Junk mail
- Envelopes (not padded)
- Computer paper
- Phone books
- Catalogues & brochures
- Tissue boxes
- Sugar bags
- Calendars
- Wrapping paper
- Post-It notes
- School copy books

### ✓ Cardboard

- Food boxes
- Cereal boxes
- Packaging boxes
- Kitchen towel tubes
- Toilet roll tubes
- Juice cartons
- Milk cartons
- Egg boxes

! Remove any plastic inserts from cardboard boxes before placing in the bin

### ✓ Plastic Containers

- Mineral & Water bottles
- Juice bottles
- Milk bottles
- Salad dressing bottles
- Yoghurt pots
- Butter tubs
- Bathroom & cosmetic bottles
- Mouthwash bottles
- Household cleaning bottles
- Laundry detergent bottles

! Remove pumps from bottles before placing in the bin

### ✓ Aluminium & Steel Cans

- Food cans
- Biscuit tins
- Aluminium drinks cans
- Clean foil trays
- Empty deodorant cans (detach plastic lid)
- Pet food cans

### ✓ Glass

- Soft drinks bottles
- Wine bottles
- Beer bottles
- Medicine bottles
- Sauce jars
- Jam jars
- Baby food jars

### ✗ Do Not Place In Your Blue Bin

- Light bulbs
- Batteries
- Crisp packets
- Plastic food & bread bags
- Garden cuttings & soil
- Polystyrene
- Food waste
- Old baby feeding bottles
- Nappies and sanitary products (including baby wipes)
- Contaminated packaging (greasy, dirty or with residue)
