At this part of the ceremony, I now invite Party 1 and Party 2 to declare that they are free to marry.

Registrar to **Party 1 Name**: Will you please repeat after me the following Declaration?

Party 1 and Party 2 will now make their marriage vows. Please face each other and if you wish hold hands.

Party 1 Name Repeats: - I call upon our Family & Friends, here present, to witness that I **Party 1 Name** take you **Party 2 Name** to be my **Husband/Wife**. To laugh with you in joy, to comfort you in sorrow, to grow with you in love, to cherish & respect you, as long as we both shall live.

Party 2 Name Repeats: - I call upon our Family & Friends, here present, to witness that I **Party 2 Name** take you **Party 1 Name** to be my **Husband/Wife**. To laugh with you in joy, to comfort you in sorrow, to grow with you in love, to cherish & respect you, as long as we both shall live.

Registrar to **Party 1 Name** - Do you solemnly promise, that you will always protect **Party 2 Name**, with your utmost care. Registrar: By virtue of these declarations, made in my presence as a Registrar of Marriages and before these witnesses, I declare that you are now joined in matrimony in accordance with the law.

Party 1 and Party 2 you may now kiss. (Optional)
