1.0 <u>Introduction</u>

The Council encourages the use of public transport to reduce the number of cars and to assist in reduction of congestion in or around town centres and urban locations.

Shelters are currently provided on the basis of requests and a need being established. 'Need criteria' is currently assessed on the general principle of the following pre-conditions:

- Number of children requiring use of the shelter as part of a bus journey to their place of education.
- Approval from the landowner, normally the Council, Department for Infrastructure (Roads), Housing Executive or other public body.
- There are no existing bus shelter facilities close by.
- Shelters are to be located in rural areas, that would not normally have a shelter provided by Translink or the Education Authority.

There are a variety of types of shelter currently in operation by the Council, ranging from Green Painted Steel shelters, mainly in rural areas, purpose built masonry shelters, prefabricated shelters and bespoke fabricated perspex shelters. There are also former 'Adshel type' shelters, which previously were managed by Translink and Adshel are now transferring to Translink to maintain as part of the overall public transport network.

The condition of the existing shelters varies with some of the shelters in a poor state of repair.

Some shelters have become dilapidated through lack of use. This can be for a variety of reasons, for example families growing up, families leaving the area, or by choosing different modes of travel to school.

2.0 Criteria

Fermanagh and Omagh District Council will continue to provide bus shelters on the basis of a demonstrable need, specifically continuing the policy around school children attending being collected to and from their place of education.

The policy will continue to operate the guiding principles for establishing need of a shelter, all of which must be met:

- Submission of a completed application form (Appendix A attached) is completed and signed by all parties wishing to avail of the installation.
- At least 5 children requiring use of the shelter as part of a bus journey to their place of education.
- Approval from the landowner, normally the Council, Department for Infrastructure (Roads), Housing Executive or other public body.
- There are no existing bus shelter facilities close by.

As resources are finite and location of shelters is reaching saturation point, the Council will also extend the following criteria for assessing bus shelter provision:

2.1 Surrender, Removal or Relocation

Surrender, removal or relocation of existing bus shelters will be assessed on current use levels over a 14 day period within a school term.

Upon evidence of no usage over a 14 day period, the Council will:-

- (i) write to householders in the vicinity of existing bus shelters regarding the 14 day notice period in relation to any proposed surrender, removal and relocation of such bus shelters:
- (ii) and a notice of removal will be placed on the shelter citing 7 days for surrender, removal and relocation, unless otherwise challenged and reported back to Council.
- (iii) All Councillors in the relevant District Electoral Area (DEA) as well as householders in the local vicinity will be notified prior to the removal of any bus shelter.

2.2 Alternative Free Provision and Maintenance of Bus Shelters

The Council will also avail of any free provision and maintenance bus shelters such as 'Adshel' or similar type providers like 'Clearchannel' in the future, should these be offered. These will only be possible to locate within 30mph zones such as town centres and urban areas.

- Full statutory approval will be in place and permission granted in writing, prior to any works commencing on site.
