Brief Description	Fermanagh and Omagh District Council makes funding available to voluntary community groups towards the cost of organising community-based Summer Schemes for children and young people (up to 17 years old) throughout Fermanagh and Omagh district.
Programme Specific Criteria	<p>Groups must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have in place Child Protection Policy and Procedures • Demonstrate a minimum of 20 hours of activity over a minimum of 4 days • Ensure that the programme offers a wide range of social recreational and educational activities appropriate to the ages and stages of development of children/young people involved • Demonstrate how the scheme meets identified local need <p>Additionally:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Schemes should be publicly advertised and be open and inclusive to everyone (some exemptions may apply) • Assessment will consider the availability of other local summer scheme provision <p>Exclusions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arts/Sports specific schemes will not be considered eligible for funding • Membership Schemes cannot be considered for funding • Staff costs are not eligible <p>Grant Aid is administered on a deficit funding basis, no grant will be paid where income exceeds expenditure.</p> <p>Please note that incomplete or retrospective applications will be deemed invalid and will <u>not</u> be considered.</p>
