Fairy Garden

You will need:

- An old plant pot or washing up bowl
- Yogurt pot
- Soil
- Grass
- Twigs

• Fallen leaves

- Pebbles
- Lollipop sticks
- Scraps of fabric
- Flowers and herbs

Now it's time to add the finishing touches! Make bunting from little scraps of fabric, and hang it among the trees. Beautiful!

Fill your plant pot or washing up bowl with soil. Push the yogurt pot into it and fill it with water to make a pond.

Use the pebbles to create paths, and make a

fence out of the

lollipop sticks.

No garden is complete without flowers and shrubs! Carefully plant the flowers, herbs and leaves, then create trees from the sticks.

Fairies and elves are very shy so you might not see them, but they love exploring new gardens!
