



Seed planting

Follow these simple steps and find out how to plant seeds

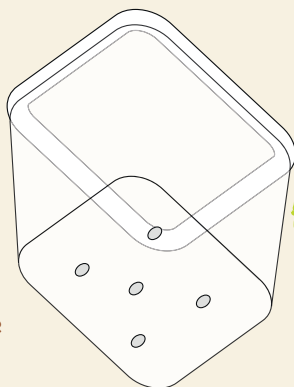
Seed planting

You will need:

- Yoghurt pot or small plastic container
- Compost or soil
- A seed or two!

1

Grab a yoghurt pot or small plastic container and make some small drainage holes in the bottom.



You might need a grown-up to help with this bit.

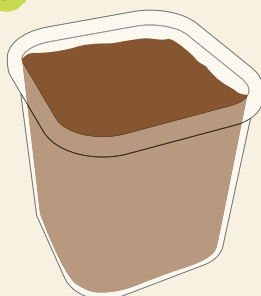

Half fill the pot with soil and pop your seed in

Cover the seed with soil until the pot is full. Gently pat it down and water it.

Keep your pot in a safe place indoors. Make sure the soil stays damp but not soggy – otherwise the seed will rot!

After a few weeks, your seed should start to grow. Watch for it sprouting and growing into a seedling.

As your seedling gets bigger, you might need to move it to a larger pot. You could plant it in your garden or school grounds. Make sure you choose a place where it will get lots of light.

In hundreds of years, your tiny seed might have grown into a huge ancient tree!

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
