Dear Sir/Madam,

As you will know works are continuing on the Enniskillen Public Realm Scheme, which includes the resurfacing of the carriageway.

We will be resurfacing the carriageway on East Bridge Street including East Bridge Place and the junction with Regal Pass commencing on Sunday 5th September. We plan to carry out these works under a night time road closure with works commencing at 18:00 each evening to 06:00 the following morning from Sunday 5th September to Sunday 12th September. Please see drawing overleaf for details on the diversion route.

East Bridge Street will be closed from 18:00 to 06:00 with a localised closing of East Bridge Place during these times to enable the works to be carried out. The road will be open from 06:00 during the day (parking will be limited), until 18:00 in the evening. Footpaths will remain open at all times.

We appreciate that this will cause disruption to the town centre, but we will try to alleviate any problems where possible to help the flow of the traffic.

Local access will be provided where possible via Regal Pass. Access will be available for emergency vehicles at all times


