The Maguire History Weekend presents a varied programme, exploring aspects of the Maguire history of Fermanagh, from castles and chalices to important historic sites and family history.

Friday 11 May (Day Event)

11 am Congregate at Enniskillen Castle.

Welcome by Sarah McHugh and enrolment with tea, coffee and biscuits.

11.30 am Tour of the Maguire stronghold at **Enniskillen Castle**, originally built over 600

years ago for Hugh 'The Hospitable' Maguire.

The castle sits next to the River Erne and was strategically important throughout its history. Guarding one of the few passes into Ulster, it became the seat of

power for the ruling Maguire chieftains in Fermanagh.

12.30 pm The Story of the Maguire Chalices with Bronagh Cleary

There are records of 5 important chalices associated with the Maguires. This talk highlights the history of the chalices from their making to their current locations in

Ireland, Scotland and Canada.

1.15 pm Lunch (Soup & Sandwiches)

2.00 pm Tour of the Fermanagh Lakelands galleries focussing on the history of the Annals

of Ulster and viewing the Maguire Chalice.

3.30pm Boat trip & tour of **Devenish Island** with its distinctive Round Tower with

Catherine Scott.

From the 6th century onwards, the Island became a place of great religious and spiritual importance as well as a burial place for a branch of the Maguire family.

Friday 11 May (Evening Event)

6.30 pm Three-course evening meal at Enniskillen Castle inspired by a medieval banquet.

Meet Hugh 'The Hospitable' and other historical characters from Enniskillen

Castle's past.

10.00am Depart Enniskillen Castle Car Park on tour bus with Catherine Scott

10.30am Field visit to Sgiath Gabhra - the inauguration site of the Maguire chieftains

of Fermanagh at Cornashee, Lisnaskea. Followed by a tea/ coffee break.

12.00pm Field visit to Aghalurcher Graveyard, an important Maguire burial site.

1.00pm Picnic lunch provided and visit to Knockninny, site of original Maguire stronghold

3pm Visit to Monea Castle, site of a former Maguire stronghold, the site is now

occupied by "Undoubtedly the most complete and best preserved of all the

Plantation castles of Ulster."

5pm Approximate time of return to Enniskillen Castle

2pm – 5pm An afternoon of Maguire Family History at Enniskillen Castle
