

Fermanagh Lakeland Forum Redevelopment Project Update

PLANNING APPLICATION

A planning application has been submitted for the redevelopment of the Fermanagh Lakeland Forum. The ambitious redevelopment plan, if approved, aims to transform the popular facility into a state-of-the-art leisure, health, and wellbeing hub.

The submission of the planning application marks a significant milestone in the project in terms of the Council's commitment to the development that will provide a wide range of indoor and outdoor leisure and recreation activities, promoting health and wellbeing, increasing access to Lough Erne with the inclusion of an active waterfront area and ensuring sustainable development is at the heart of this major capital project.

The Fermanagh Lakeland Forum has been a cornerstone of the local community for decades, offering a wide range of sporting, recreational, and cultural activities. However, recognising the need for modernisation and expansion, the Council has embarked on an innovative journey to revitalise this iconic facility. The Council have approved the proposed redevelopment progress to Full Business Case Stage which includes the commencement of Planning and procurement processes.
