Submission Guidelines

For poetry:

1. Submit no more than 5 poems, totalling a maximum of 5 pages.
2. Each poem submitted should begin on a separate page.
3. Poems may be single-spaced.
4. Poems must be typed, in 12-point Times Roman, 11-point Calibri or similar normal-sized, recognizable font.
5. Your name and email address should appear clearly at the top left corner of each poem submitted. If you do not have an email address, you may substitute a postal address.
6. Previously published work is permitted, provided you hold the publication rights. Please note on the submission if (and where) a poem has been published.
7. Send all poems in a single Word or Wordx document as an attachment to culture@fermanaghomagh.com
In the body of the email, include a short bio of 50-100 words.
8. allow 6 months for a final decision.
9. You may submit work in the prose category as well.
10. Poems must be submitted no later than midnight, on Friday May 17. This is a firm deadline. Once work is submitted, substitutions or revisions will not be accepted.

For prose:

1. Submit no more than 3 prose pieces, totalling a maximum of 6 double-spaced pages.
2. Each prose piece submitted should begin on a separate page.
3. No prose piece should exceed 3 pages (about 1000 words). Shorter works are preferred.
4. Prose must be double-spaced.
5. All work must be typed, in 12-point Times Roman, 11-point Calibri or similar normal-sized, recognizable font.

6. Prose may be in the genre of fiction, lyric essay, memoir, or any form of creative non-fiction. Please indicate whether the piece is fiction or nonfiction.
7. Your name and email address should appear clearly at the top left corner of each piece submitted. If you do not have an email address, you may substitute a postal address.
8. Previously published work is permitted, provided you hold the publication rights. Please note on the submission if (and where) a piece has been published.
9. Send all work in a single Word or Wordx document as an attachment to culture@fermanaghmagh.com
In the body of the email, include a short bio of 50-100 words.
10. Allow 6 months for a final decision.
11. You may submit work in the poetry category as well.
12. Work must be submitted no later than midnight, on Friday May 17. This is a firm deadline. Once work is submitted, substitutions or revisions will not be accepted.
