FOCUS ON: ENNISKILLEN PUBLIC REALM



Paving and kerbing is progressing well on the project with a number of areas now complete. Kerbing and paving is now complete from Café Cellini to Regal Pass.

On Church Street, kerbing and paving has been completed from Vincent's to St Michael's Church, and on Darling Street from St Michael's down to Wesley Street. Paving and kerbing is also completed on the right hand side of Paget Square.

38 of the street lighting columns have been installed to date, with 21 lanterns fitted. Tree pits installed to date is 9. The trees are due to be planted in March 2022. Drainage improvement works remain substantially complete. We have 23% of the pavement areas now completed.
