1. Background

Fermanagh and Omagh District Council has secured €5.6m to deliver a PEACEPLUS Local Community Action Plan for the district to promote positive relations between people from different backgrounds and communities. The programme is supported by the European Union's PEACEPLUS Programme, managed by the Special EU Programmes Body (SEUPB).

The PEACEPLUS Local Community Action Plan will support 13 programmes or initiatives across three key themes, Local Community Regeneration and Transformation, Thriving and Peaceful Communities and Celebrating Cultures and Diversity.

The Local Community Action Plan has been developed following extensive consultation during 2022/2023 with local communities to ensure actions address their needs and issues identified. A voluntary PEACEPLUS Partnership Board comprised of Councillors and representatives from statutory agencies and social partners will support and monitor the effective delivery of the Local Community Action Plan.

PEACEPLUS is supported by the European Union, the UK Government, the Northern Ireland Executive and Irish Government. It is managed by the Special EU Programmes Body (SEUPB).

Conditions of Participation:

Successful groups and organisations will be required to:

- Enter into a Development Contract to meet the requirements of the PEACEPLUS Programme as specified by SEUPB and the Council.
- Strive to achieve representative participation from all communities in all activities.

PLEASE NOTE: This is a competitive process.

The submission of an Expression of Interest is **MANDATORY** to be considered under the Community Regeneration & Transformation Programme but **DOES NOT** indicate that your submission will be selected for participation in the programme.

PEACEPLUS: Community Regeneration & Transformation Programme Introduction

In its role as lead partner Fermanagh and Omagh District Council wishes to invite Expressions of Interest under the PEACEPLUS Community Regeneration & Transformation Programme – a Capital Programme aimed at upgrading existing community spaces and/or halls to bring them up to a higher standard to increase usage.

Project Definition

It has been determined that at least 10 communities / areas within Fermanagh and Omagh will be engaged in the project. In the interests of geographical equity, at least one community / area from each District Electoral Area (DEA) will be selected. A number of additional projects may be held in reserve based on the assessment outcome and availability of finances.





Projects up to a maximum capital value of £43,500 (inc consultancy fees) will be considered. A maximum 10% of the overall cost will be available for purchase of capital equipment.

Funding for recurrent or activity costs is not available within this programme.

Assistance will be provided to the selected projects to develop appropriate activity programmes with an additional value of up to £13,000 per project to support these activities.

Conditions of Participation:

Successful groups and organisations will be required to:

- Enter into a development contract to meet the requirements of the PEACEPLUS Programme as specified by SEUPB and the Council.
- Participate in capacity building/facilities training.
- Delivery of a programme of activity.
- Strive to achieve cross community participation in all activity's representative of the demography of the area.
- A capital improvement scheme to upgrade existing community spaces/halls to bring them up to a higher standard to increase usage.
