Recycling your food waste has never been easier

Fermanagh & Omagh District Council food waste collection service

Have you got the right equipment?

You'll need a kitchen caddy, a brown wheeled recycling bin and a roll of liners. If you don't have any of these, call **0300 303 1777**

1. Line your kitchen caddy with one of the liners and put your food waste in it.



Top tip
If you would rather use your own indoor container that's fine – do whatever works for you

2. Whenever you need to empty your caddy, tie the top and put it in your brown wheeled recycling bin.



Top tip
Remember to not let your caddy get too full before emptying it

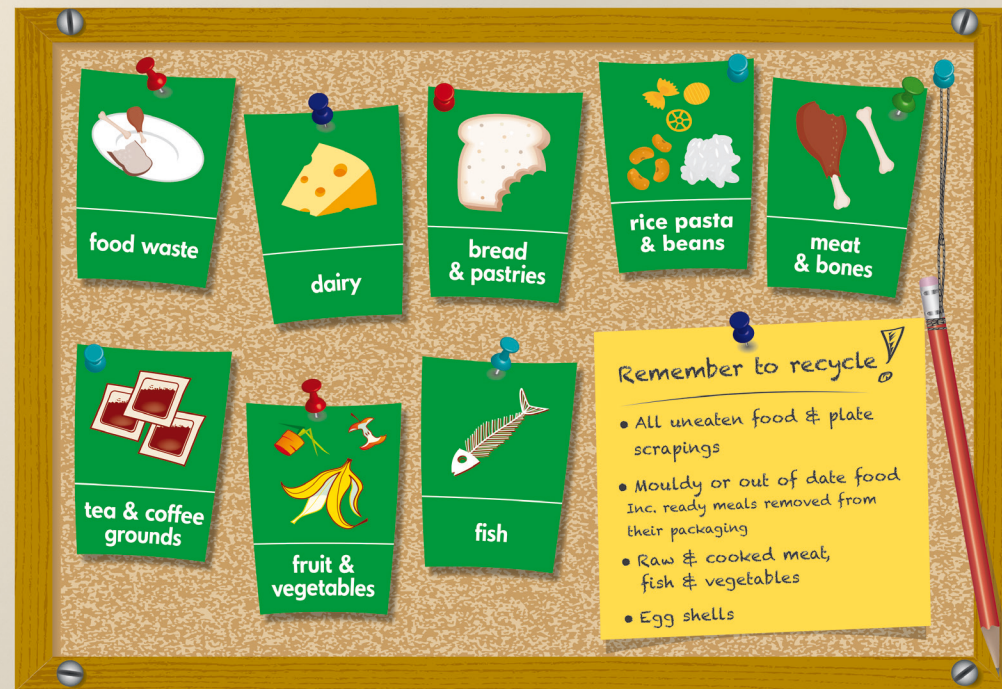
3. Please put your food recycling out for collection by 7:00am on your normal collection day.

Garden waste recycling

You can recycle all your organic garden waste with your food waste through your brown bin. Please place all your organic waste loose into your brown bin.

Top tips

- Don't fill your bin with soil. This is too heavy for the lifting gear on the lorry
- Lining your bin with newspaper or cardboard will prevent the material sticking to the bottom of the bin
- Remember to present your bin all year round no matter how little is in it
