

Tips for recycling food waste



Make sure your food waste bin is out for collection with your blue bin by 7:00 am on your collection day and can be seen clearly.



Tie your compostable liner to keep your food waste bin clean. Remember to keep good hygiene by washing hands, caddies and surfaces with soap and hot water.

need more liners?

Compostable liners are available free of charge from the council recycling centres and public service centre Omagh. Only compostable liners supplied or recommended by the council will be accepted.



Keep your caddy clean by rinsing with water or wiping with kitchen towel.

Your food waste service


We are introducing a separate food waste collection into your area. You will have received a food waste bin (large) a food waste caddy (small) and a roll of compostable liners to enable your food waste to be recycled. The food waste bin will be collected fortnightly and should be presented on the same day and time as your blue recycling bin.

Food waste placed in your residual (black) bin goes to landfill. It costs you money and is bad for the environment. The food waste you present for recycling is taken to a specialised plant where it is recycled to compost.

What can I put in my caddy?

You can put any raw or cooked food in your caddy. You can even scrape uneaten food straight into your caddy.

- ✓ Meat and fish - raw and cooked including bones.
- ✓ Fruit and vegetables - raw and cooked.
- ✓ All dairy products such as eggs and cheese.
- ✓ Bread, cakes and pastries.
- ✓ Rice, pasta and beans.
- ✓ Uneaten food from your plates and dishes.
- ✓ Tea bags and coffee grounds.



No Thanks

Please do not put any of these materials in your caddy.

- ✗ Packaging of any sort.
- ✗ Plastic bags.
- ✗ Liquids.
- ✗ Oil or liquid fat.


How do I use my food caddy?



1 Line your caddy with a compostable liner and fill it with food waste. **Do not use plastic bags.**



2 When it is full tie the liner and put it in your food bin.



3 Keep your food bin outside and out of direct sunlight. To help stop pests lock the outside bin by moving the handle forward.
