Details

Please give details of why you consider the Plan Strategy to be unsound having regard to the test(s) you have identified above. Please be as precise as possible.

Draft Policy IB02 states that alternative uses on land zoned for industry and business uses will not be permitted. Proposals which result in the loss of land and floorspace used, or last used, for industry or business use, will only be permitted in a very limited number of circumstances.

The SPPS advocates a flexible approach to alternative uses on such land and we would encourage Fermanagh & Omagh District Council to follow that guidance.

This policy as drafted is too restrictive and will result in former industrial land lying vacant. It will stymie regeneration and economic growth, contrary to RG7 (Support Urban and Rural Renaissance) of the Regional Development Strategy (RDS).

This policy fails the following tests of soundness:

- C1 as it is inconsistent with RG7 of the RDS;
- C3 as it does not take account of the SPPS;
- CE2 as it is not an appropriate policy.

Modifications

The policy should be re-drafted to provide that alternative uses on zoned land and unzoned land used or last used for industry or business use will be permitted where the land is not a vital local industrial land resource and its development for alternative uses will not result in a shortfall of such land during the course of the Plan period.
This is similar to the policy approach of the 1997 version of PPS4. This will permit the regeneration of vacant sites/ buildings whilst ensuring that there will be no prejudice to Plan's ability to meet the needs of industrial users.
