The protected route policy relates to protected roads network that traverse through the FODC area the road are identified by A5, A32, A4, A509 & A505 These roads have been designated for at least the past 30 years FODC has not assessed the impact that this restrictive policy has had on the rural communities that live on and near the protected routes especially regarding the lack of development opportunities & the restriction this policy has had on their Businesses farms and homes  There has been no policies developed to address the many issues experienced by the rural communities in these areas.  Depopulation in these areas is very common the Rural Population is not being sustained Rural schools and businesses are contracting or closing down
