Brief Description	The Sports Team Grant is to support and provide assistance to sporting teams who have been selected or qualified to compete at the highest level (e.g., event / tournament / competition / final) within their sport, following a performance based process.
	Teams can avail of Sports Team Grant funding to assist with the following event expenditure:
	 Entry Fees Travel Costs e.g., flights / ferries / bus / trains etc. Accommodation Costs
	A maximum amount of £500.00 per team is available within any financial year.
	Applications will be accepted on an ongoing basis.
	Applications must be received prior to the event / tournament / competition / final taking place. Applications cannot be made retrospectively.
	Assessment of applications may not be carried out until after the event takes place.
	Applicants should retain evidence of all expenditure incurred.

Specific Criteria	 Be involved in an amateur capacity. Reside in the Fermanagh and Omagh District Council area or represent the District through participation. Enter only one competition / event per application. Be selected or qualified to compete at the highest level within their sport, following a performance based process. Provide a signed letter from a National Governing Body of Sport (NGB), confirming point 4. The letter must be submitted with the Sports Bursary application.
	NGB must:
	6. Be recognised by a Sports Council - via either of the links below.
	 OR 7. Provide evidence that it is affiliated to a NGB recognised by a Sports Council. This must be a signed letter from the recognised NGB that the NGB is affiliated to.

The following are not eligible for the Sports Team Grant: 8. Applicants based outside the Fermanagh and Omagh District Council area. 9. Semi-professional or professional teams. 10. Retrospective applications. 11. Teams who have who have been selected or qualified to compete at the highest level within their sport, following a performance based process 12. Teams who have not provided a signed NGB supporting evidence and documentation. 13. NGB is not recognised by a Sports Council e.g., Sport NI, Sport Ireland, UK/GB. 14. NGB is not affiliated to a NGB recognised by a Sports Council; and/or no evidence that the NGB is affiliated to a NGB recognised by a Sports Council. 15. Expenditure incurred with training camps, training programmes or friendly events. 16. Car hire and mileage travel costs. **Conditions and Administrative arrangements:** 17. All applications will be considered on an individual basis against the eligibility criteria by a relevant Director or Head of Service and reported to the Council's Grant Aid Award Panel and Regeneration and Community Meeting. 18. Applications will only be assessed if all the necessary information has been provided. 19. Fermanagh and Omagh District Council may defer applications if further information is required or if the application form and supporting evidence is not completed properly. 20. Submission of an application does not necessarily mean that financial assistance will be granted. 21. Any award of funding is subject to budget availability. 22. The financial assistance is offered on a deficit basis and an income / expenditure report must be submitted with a claim. **Maximum** Amount Up to a maximum of £500 per team (per financial year).
