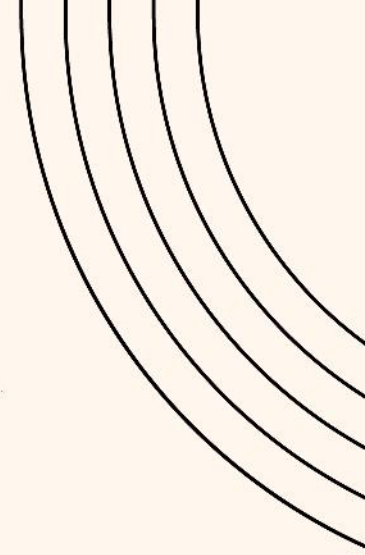

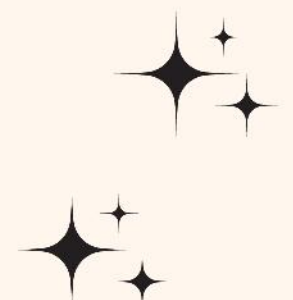
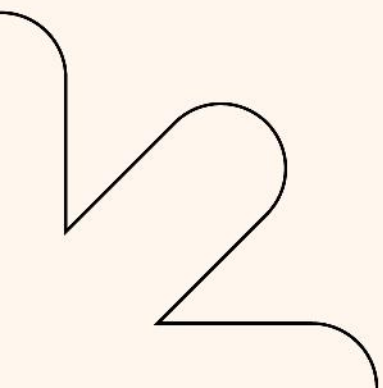

their adventures and favourite memories.



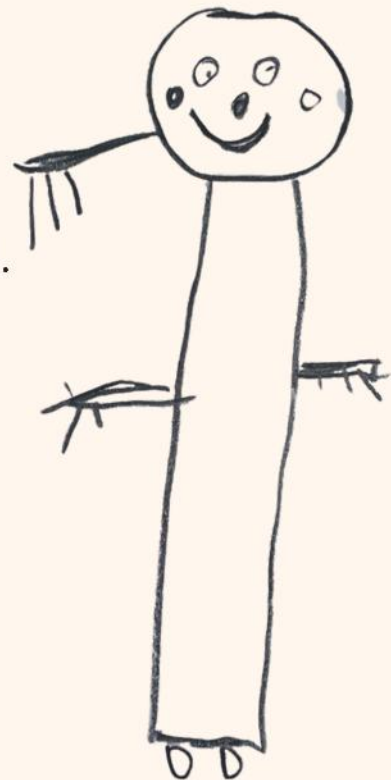
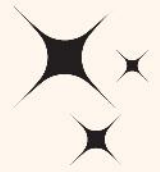

My Dog Molly - by Liam

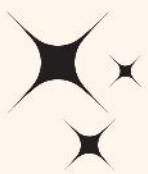
When she is happy to see me

By Ryan

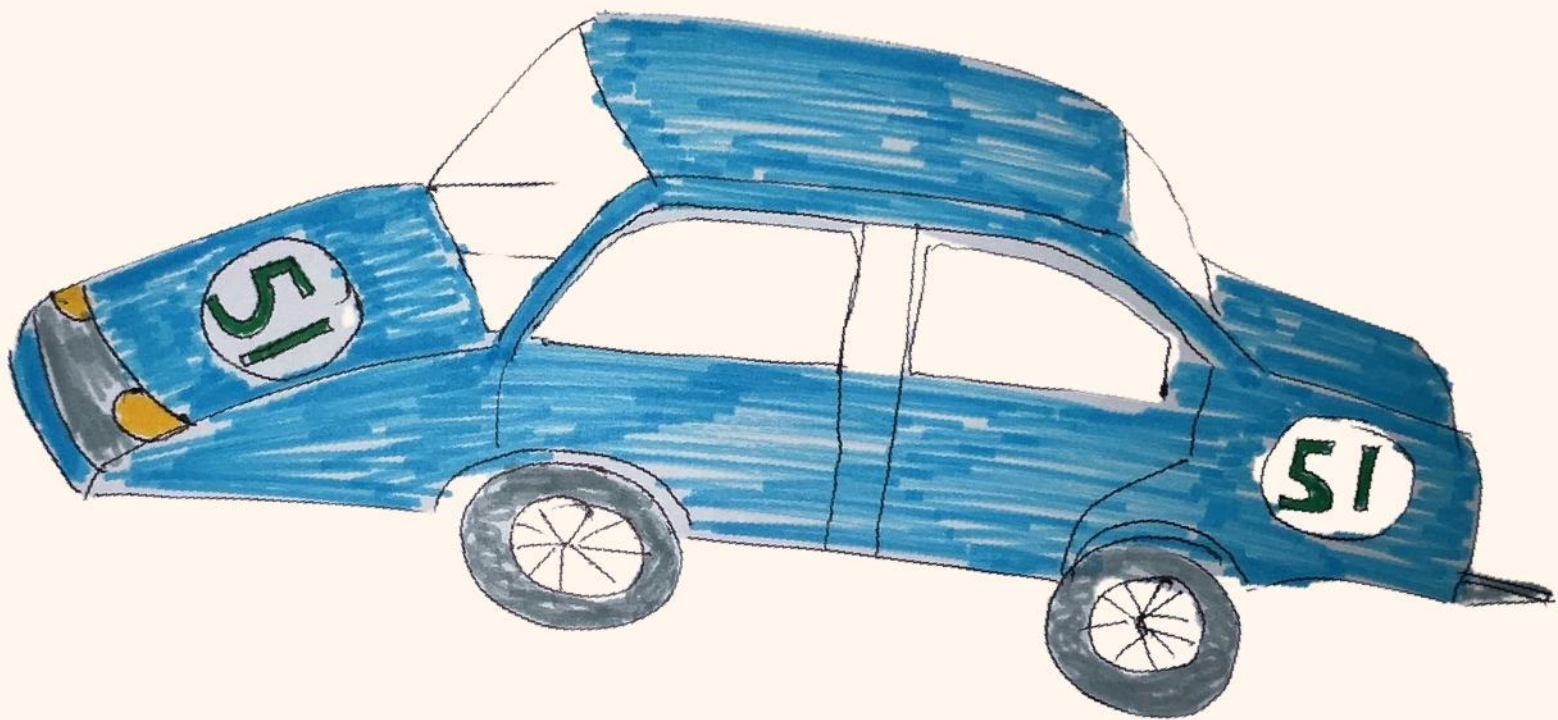
I see lots of black, red and blue rally cars

watching the rally.



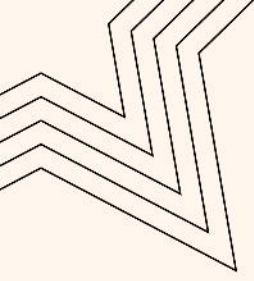
Tommy

I feel really happy when I am outside.





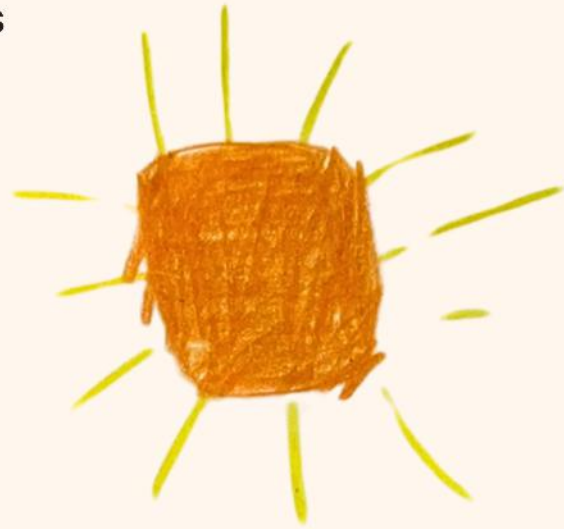
Family and Cowboys

I love to eat it really quickly

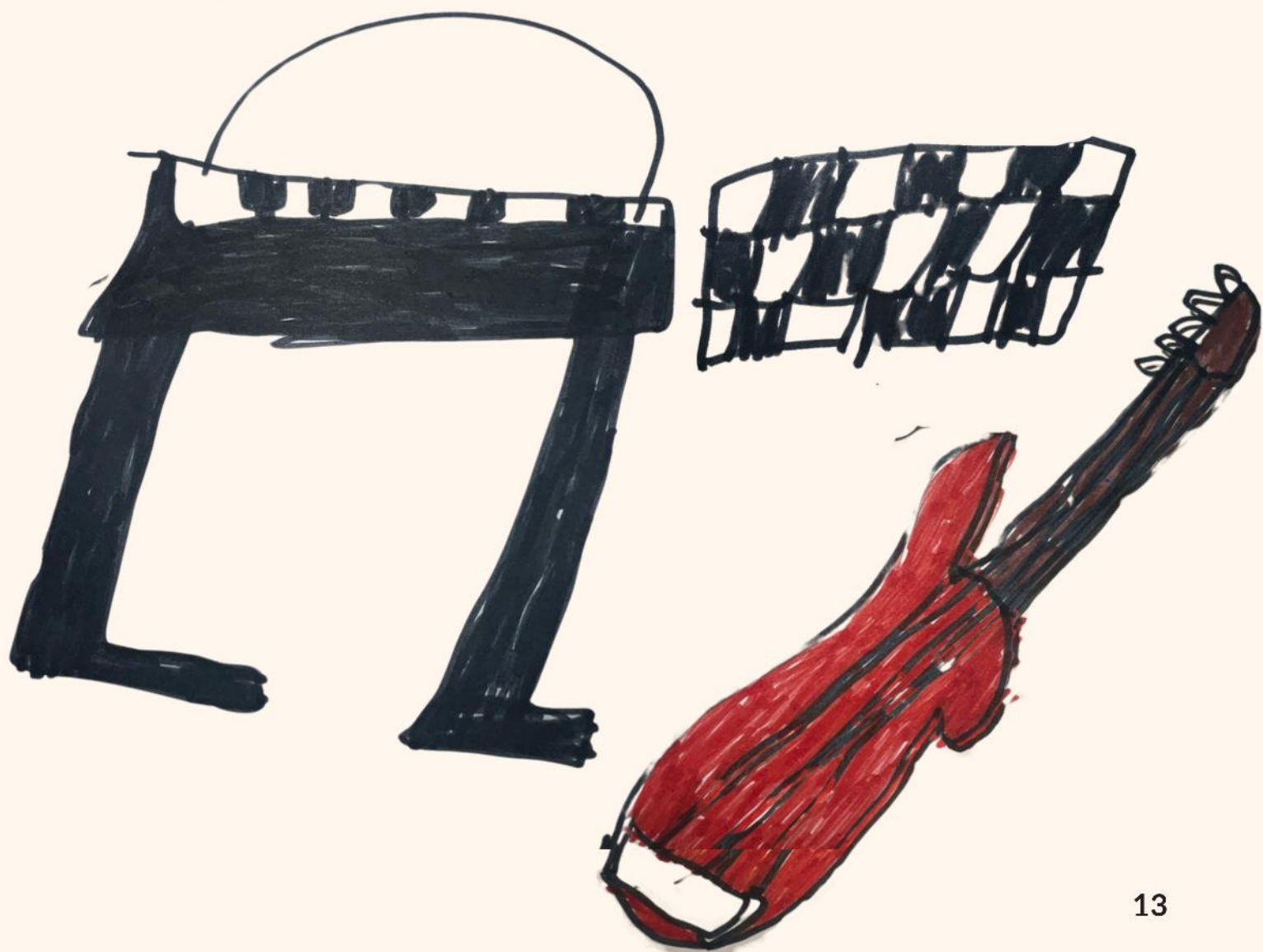
I feel my Mum's hugs and kisses
They make me feel happy and special.

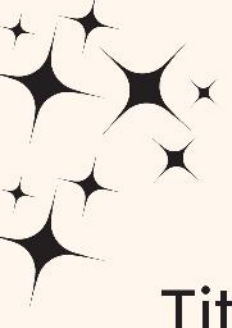


Music

It is so cold on my hands.



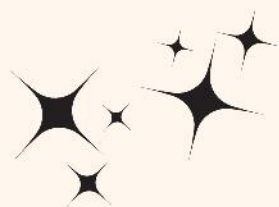


Trucks

By Jack

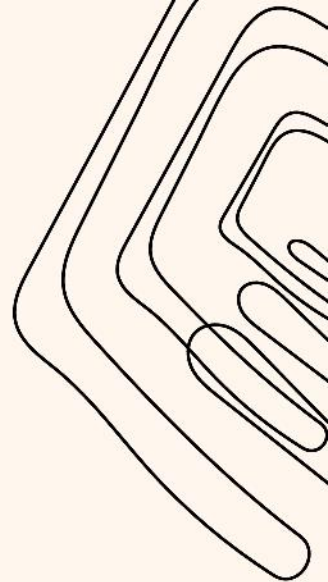
I see blue, white and black trucks

I see Bo the dog.

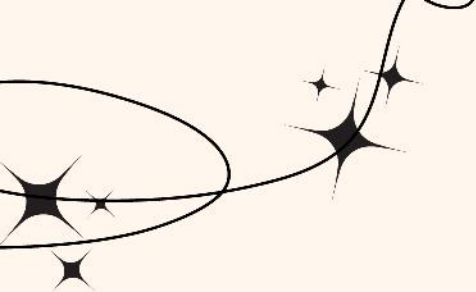
I hear Bo softly barking

I love Bo.



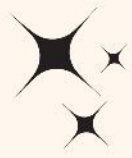


My Favourite things

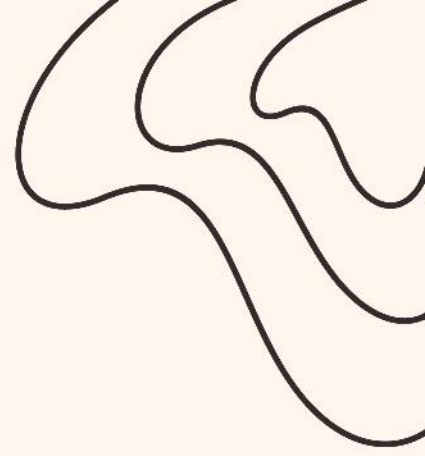
By Molly
