Car Park

Car Parking is available in front of the main entrance.

There are 9 blue badge spaces.

It is also possible to drop someone off at the main entrance doors.

Getting to the Entrance

You can get to the entrance from a footpath along the main road and a ramped pedestrian walkway from the car park.

There are dropped kerbs along the footpaths from the car park and a level pathway up to the front door.

Entrance

To enter the Complex, you have to go through the main glass doors into an entrance foyer.

The doors are automatic.

There are stairs or a lift to go the upper floor and Reception.

Reception

The reception desk is to the right of the upper foyer area.

The reception desk has a lowered level and a hearing loop system.

The Buddy Scheme provides a complimentary entrance to a person for their companion, where that person would not be able to attend or use the services at the Leisure Complex without that companion.

To access any of the services please scan your membership card or pay the fee to a member of staff.



Lift

A lift is available opposite Reception to the lower level, as well as one beside the Upper Activity Room.

Changing Rooms

There are changing rooms for the the Gym on the upper floor.

The Changing Village for the Swimming Pool is on the lower floor just beside the pool. There is level access and automatic double doors.

A number of accessible changing facilities are available at each of the areas.

For the swimming pool, an accessible changing facility with adult changing bed and hoist is located to the left of the changing village.



Main Hall

The Minor Hall is on the first floor, near the reception area.

It has level access and double doors at all entrances.



Lower Activity Room

The Lower Activity Room is on the ground floor.

It has level access.

Tables and chairs can be moved to suit the visitor's requirements.

Upper Activity Room

The Upper Activity Room is on the upper floor, just past the swimming pool viewing area.

It has level access and double doors.

Tables and chairs can be moved to suit the visitor's requirements.

Conference Room

The Conference Room is on the upper floor, just past the reception area.

It has level access.



Swimming Pool

The steps into the swimming pool are located just in front of the changing rooms.

There are handrails at the sides of the steps.

A Pool Pod is available to the right of the pool. The pod allows people with a disability to be lowered gently into the pool.

There may be a lot of splashing while there are others in the pool.

The water in the pool will be cool.

There will be a strong chemical smell in the room.
