

Getting to the Entrance

There are two entrances into the venue:

- Front entrance path with a slight incline and steps.
- Rear entrance with ramped approach and handrails.

There are dropped kerbs along all footpaths at the front and rear of the building.

Both entrance doors are automatic.



Reception

The reception counter is located just inside the main foyer.

The counter has a lowered level at both sides.

A hearing loop system is available.

A member of staff will be at reception to help you with your query.

Registry & Meeting Rooms

The Registration Offices are on the ground floor.

The smaller meeting rooms are on the ground and first floors.

There is a lift to the first floor available at reception.

The rooms have level access, white walls and carpeted floors.

Training Room

The Training Room can be accessed from a separate entrance from the accessible car parking spaces or through the downstairs office area.

The room is used for meetings, events and Marriage/ Civil Partnership Ceremonies.

It has grey carpeted flooring and white walls.

The tables and chairs are wooden and can be arranged to suit the visitors.

Chamber

The Chamber is located on the first floor.

The Chamber is a room used to hold Council meetings. Each seat is allocated to Councillors and Staff Officers.

There is a platform lift to the raised area for the Committee Chairpersons and Officers.

The room has white walls, brown carpet, black chairs and dark wooden desks.
